<b>Qualifications</b>	Degree/CEng/IEng/TPP N/SVQ Level 5	N/A	Applicants should normally hold a recognised professional qualification in another professional discipline
<b>Practical Experience</b>	Applicants will be expected to demonstrate significant and extensive experience and to have held a position of senior responsibility within the field of highways and/or transportation for at least 2 years.	Applicants will be expected to demonstrate significant and extensive experience and to have held a position of senior responsibility within the field of highways and/or transportation for at least 5 years.	Applicants will hold senior Board-level post in a large national or multi-national highways and/or transportation company or a senior post within a government department which has a direct influence on transportation policy.
<b>Level of Responsibility</b>	<p>During the qualifying period, applicants would be expected to demonstrate key responsibility relating to, for example</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Projects of significant regional or national value</li> <li>- Control of major proportion of company budget</li> <li>- Professional or technical responsibility for project delivery</li> <li>- Overseeing Innovative operational research</li> <li>- Providing advice in a specialist area at an influential level</li> <li>-</li> </ul> <p>Applicants should also provide evidence that they have maintained their own professional development.</p> <p>The list below gives examples of those who may satisfy the requirements for election at Fellow grade:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Director/senior manager in a large or medium-sized organisation</li> <li>• Civil servant with responsibility for whole areas of policy or practice within central or regional government</li> <li>• Chief Officer in a local authority</li> <li>• Senior academic (Dean or Head of Department)</li> <li>• Head of a team of several researchers, with overall responsibility for direction of the research</li> <li>• Sole practitioner providing a widely-recognised high level of expertise</li> <li>• Senior post in small organisation providing a widely-recognised high level of expertise</li> <li>• Senior officer in the police force, the armed forces and the like.</li> </ul>		<p>It is expected that senior responsibility will include, for example:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Chief Executive in a large organisation</li> <li>• Government minister with responsibility for transportation</li> <li>• Chief Executive of a large Shire County or Metropolitan Borough Council</li> <li>• Senior Civil Servant (grade 5 or above) with responsibility for transportation</li> <li>• University Vice Chancellor</li> </ul>
