The Transport Planning Professional (TPP) qualification was developed by the Chartered Institution of Highways and Transportation (CIHT) and the Transport Planning Society (TPS). It enhances the standing of transport planning as a career and acknowledges transport planners as respected professionals, whilst encouraging the development of the skills needed to tackle the major challenges facing the transport sector. Once candidates have successfully completed the TPP assessment they are eligible for Chartered status as a Chartered Transport Planning Professional (CTPP).

This seminar will provide an overview of what is required to becoming CTPP qualified, and the necessary preparation required. It is an opportunity to engage in an interactive discussion with CIHT's Head of Education and Professional Development, TPP reviewer, mentors, and candidates in their journeys.
