Individual projects (less than £5 million) that are outstanding examples of transportation or highway projects, demonstrating they have been delivered on time, to budget and made a major contribution to the West Midlands. In addition, this year the judges welcome examples that demonstrate effective management considering the current social and financial crisis on the health safety and wellbeing of workforce and customers.

Entries must clearly explain how the submission meets the criteria specified.

- Implementation and delivery of project (10)
- Engagement and communication with Stakeholders (10)
- Planning and Design (10)

- Value for money with benefits versus costs (10)
- Wider implementation potential (5)
