This Awards recognises all the allies who are carrying out outstanding work in the field of highways and transportation not just on projects but overall, shaping the lives around us.

## Judging Criteria for the award:

- **Biography/Overview of Achievements.** Provide a short biography of the nominee, focusing on their key achievements. Highlight their mentoring support and any significant contributions to the industry. (25)
- **Commitment to Mentoring/Supporting Women**. Detail how the nominee's commitment to mentoring and supporting women has made a difference. Explain why this commitment is important and the impact it has had. (25)
- **Reason for Shortlisting**. Explain why the nominee should be shortlisted for their achievements in the highways and transportation sector for this category. Focus on their standout accomplishments and the significance of their contributions. (25)
- Statement of Recommendation. Include a statement of recommendation from women who have been supported or mentored by the nominee. Highlight specific examples of how the nominee's support has made a positive impact. (25)
