Rachel Smith is an Associate Director at Jacobs in London. She's a solutionsfocussed transport planner with a passion for getting people to look and think about things differently. Her career spans 24 years working in the private and public sectors in the UK, Australia, and New Zealand.

Described by News Ltd as "one of the brightest thinkers on perpetual challenge of urban planning". She is the award-winning author of Decongestion a 'how to' cut traffic congestion without the expense of new roads or annoyed residents. She created the concept for 7 metre wide Cycling Superhighways, co-founded Lazy Sunday Cycle and during the 1st

COVID-19 lockdown researched when we're compelled to change our habits/behaviours and why we're not.

She's given two TEDx talks, was a curator of the BMW Guggenheim Lab urban think-tank in New York, Mumbai and Berlin and has spoken in London's House of Lords about the importance of including women and kids in transport planning. She is best-known globally for inspiring thousands of women to cut, curb, slow and even quit shopping. She didn't buy anything new or 2<sup>nd</sup> hand in 2014 and saved 38% of her salary.
